Surveillance Testing

Brucellosis canis Blood Draw **FREE**

*Onchocerca lupi Skin Biopsy **FREE**

Testing Done At Sites or Appointments Can Be Made At
Veterinary Clinics (Tse Bonito, Chinle & Shiprock).

Requirments:

- Distemper, Deworm, Microchip & Frontline can be given as early as 8 weeks (2 months).
- Rabies, Bravecto & Seresto can be given as early as 12 weeks (3 months).
- Please keep animals in vehicle; puppies/dogs on a leash or in a carrier, kittens/cats in a carrier or a pillowcase.
- Please let staff know if pets have wounds, are sick, aggressive or feral and if they are showing signs of illness.

Note:

- **SURVEILLANCE TESTING** (*) "Onchocerca lupi" requires sedation. PLEASE DO NOT feed pet after 9pm before testing day. Drop off time before 12pm & Pick up time at 3pm. "Brucellosis canis" does NOT require sedation, blood draw only.
- Call backs & treatments depend on test results. Test results can take up to 6 months.
